

HOW TO REGISTER FOR THE SAT

- ❖ Go to <http://sat.collegeboard.org/home>
- ❖ Click on the blue “Register Now” box (in the upper right corner of the screen)
- ❖ If you don’t have a College Board account, click on the blue “Sign Up” box (lower right side of screen); otherwise, click on Sign In.
- ❖ Click on the blue “Register for the SAT” box.
- ❖ Complete all of the required personal and academic information.
- ❖ Read the Terms & Conditions. Click on the “I Agree” checkbox.
- ❖ Select the date you would like to take the SAT.
- ❖ If you have a fee waiver, click on “Yes, I have a fee waiver” and entire the required information. (If you participate in the free/reduced lunch program, see your Counselor for an SAT fee waiver. You are eligible to take the SAT using a fee waiver up to two times.)
- ❖ Search for a test center by entering the zip code, school name, or school code. (Audubon High School’s zip code is 08106 and the school code is 310045).
- ❖ Please note – Audubon High School does NOT offer the SAT in November but if you opt to take the November SAT, several local schools do offer it (i.e. Haddon Heights, Collingswood, Haddonfield, etc.)
- ❖ Upload a photo for your SAT admission ticket. Please read the directions very carefully to ensure you upload an acceptable photo.
- ❖ Print out your Admission Ticket and be sure to bring it with you on the date of your scheduled SAT
- ❖ For students with disabilities: In order to take the SAT with testing accommodations, students must see their counselor at least three months before the desired SAT date (for the October SAT, at least four months prior) to complete and submit the required paperwork to request approval for accommodations; accommodation requests are not guaranteed and must be approved by the College Board.

Admission Ticket photo requirement...

You are responsible for providing an acceptable photo when you register. To be acceptable, it must:

- ❖ Be clear with proper lighting and focus
- ❖ Be taken in full-face view, directly facing the camera
- ❖ Be of only you; photos containing multiple people are unacceptable
- ❖ Match how you will look on the day of the test and match your photo ID

IMPORTANT CHANGES for registration and test day:

- ❖ You will be required to provide a photo in order to register for the SAT
- ❖ You must present your Admission Ticket with your acceptable photo ID to enter your test center. No ticket, no ID, no admission!
- ❖ Standby test-takers will not be admitted.
- ❖ Changes to test center, test date or test type will not be permitted on test day.

Bring these items on test day

- Your acceptable photo ID
- Your photo Admission Ticket
- No. 2 pencils and a soft eraser
- Acceptable calculator

Photo ID requirements

To be acceptable, your ID must be:

- School or government issued
- Original and valid (unexpired)
- In good condition and exactly matching the information you provided at registration
